

**GREG ANDRES**

Greg Andres is the Chief of the Criminal Division in the United States Attorney's Office for the Eastern District of New York; he has served in that Office in various positions since 1999.

Mr. Andres graduated from the University of Chicago Law School in 1995, where he was a member on the *University of Chicago Law Review*. After graduation, Mr. Andres clerked for the Honorable Judge Morton A. Brody on the United States District Court for the District of Maine and later for the Honorable Robert R. Beezer on the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit. Mr. Andres was a litigation associate at the law firm of Davis Polk & Wardwell from 1997 to 1999. Prior to law school, Mr. Andres served as a Peace Corps Volunteer in Benin, West Africa. Mr. Andres is the recipient of two Director's Awards from the Department of Justice, the Attorney General's Award for Distinguished Service and in 2005 he was awarded the Henry L. Stimson Medal by New York County Bar Association. In 2005, Mr. Andres was named in the National Law Journal's "40 Under 40" as one of the top 40 attorneys in the United States under the age of 40.
